TO : Commanding Officer, Student Training Regiment,
Fort Benning, Georgia

1. It has been noted by the undersigned that the proposed T/D, to be put in effect in the near future, lists one (1) Captain and one (1) Lieutenant as Company Officers. This will be a change to the T/D now in effect which lists two (2) Captains and one (1) Lieutenant.

2. It is requested that the following facts be considered with the view of maintaining a Captain within the Organization as Executive Officer.

a. The following are normal duties which are performed by the Company Officers of this organization:

- (1) Supply Officer activities
- (2) Mess Officer activities
- (3) Investigations (Post policy desires sworn affidavits from all witnesses involved)
- (4) Summary Court activities (Performed by the Company Commander)
- (5) Special Court activities in which all officers of this organization are involved.
- (6) Unit Fund, Property, etc.

b. In addition to the above one (1) officer must visit each committee chairman weekly to receive suggestions, transmit requests and keep general liaison between the Company and the sections. This essentially calls for a Captain as the Company representative because of the rank involved in the sections.

c. The discipline of the organization depends on the conduct and activities of the Company Officers. It should be kept in mind that there are only twenty two (22) Pvs and Pfc's in this organization, the remainder being non-commissioned officers, the majority in 1st three grade category.

3. This organization has utilized the services of two (2) Captains and one (1) 1st Lieutenant to good advantage in the past and it is felt that the efficiency of the Company would be materially decreased if the provisions of the new T/D are effected.





1. Reference: Letter Hq TIS GNKEB 322, subject, Personnel Allotments, TD Units, The Infantry School, dated 16 June 1947 as amended by letter Hq TIS, same subject and file number, dated 25 June 1947.

2. It is desired that you prepare and furnish G-1 this headquarters prior to 15 August 1947 Tables of Distribution and Organizational and Functional charts for your command based on the following:

- a. Anticipated work load in October 1947.
- b. Reduction of one Lt Col and one Capt in the personnel allotment authorized by the reference cited in Par 1 above.
- c. Adding a section of three drivers for official cars used by this headquarters. The grades for drivers will be, one grade III and two grade IV.
- d. Mess personnel to be calculated for consolidated mess using as a basis for computation the authorized allotment of enlisted personnel of all units presently participating in the mess, except "H" Company Airborne Battalion. Mess personnel for this unit will be calculated in the TD for STR.

3. All possible savings in enlisted spaces will be effected. It is believed that spaces for the drivers mentioned above will be provided for in your present allotment when mess personnel are calculated on the basis of a consolidated mess. In the event it becomes necessary to ask for additional spaces, the request should be directed to G-1 this headquarters.

2. It is desired that you prepare and furnish G-1 this headquarters prior to 15 August 1947, final drafts of Tables of Distribution and Organizational and Functional charts for your command based on the following:

- a. Reorganization of STR on Main Post as outlined in your letter of 21 July 1947.
- b. Work load calculated for October 1947.
- c. Biglerville consolidated mess to be manned by white personnel.
- d. Smaller messes required for 1st Battalion to be manned by negro mess personnel.
- e. Airborne battalion messes to be manned by white personnel.
- f. All negro personnel assigned to TIS to be administered in Service Co STR. This will include approximately 36 for S-4 TIS in addition to those assigned or on DS with your command.
- g. Using 211 negro enlisted assignment spaces.
- h. Janitors and firemen for the academic buildings located in Harmony Church area and in the Airborne area being taken over by S-4, TIS.
- i. Effecting all possible economy of enlisted spaces. It is expected that a considerable saving of personnel from the allotment authorized by the reference cited in Par 1 will be accomplished.

SUBJECT: Organization of Service Company, 1st Bn, Stu Tng Regt

TO: The Commandant

1. Under the proposed Table of Distribution of The Infantry School a considerable increase in the number of colored personnel to be utilized is contemplated, a goodly number being used in the 1st Battalion, Student Training Regiment. This plan also contemplates the establishment of a Service Company for the housing and feeding of colored personnel used in the area of the 1st Battalion. The proposed Table of Distribution overhead for this company is a total of 2 officers (white) and 24 enlisted men (colored).

2. During the period of Air Indoctrination, the 25th Infantry has maintained an overhead detachment in the 1st Battalion area for the purpose of servicing the colored personnel belonging to their organization but on duty with Air Indoctrination and the 1st Battalion, STR. Following the closing of Air Indoctrination, it is contemplated that a minimum of 70 colored personnel will be required in the 1st Battalion area. With the arrival of additional officer companies this number will be increased. It is understood that the 25th Infantry contemplates the removal of their overhead detachment on or about Wednesday, 7 May 1947.

3. It is requested that the contemplated Service Company, 1st Battalion, STR be organized prior to that date to furnish an overhead unit and mess for the 70 personnel remaining on duty in that area. It is believed advisable that the colored personnel for the formation of this company be furnished from the overhead of the present detachment of the 25th Infantry at present in the 1st Battalion area. There is no available mess in the area of the 1st Battalion, STR to house and mess colored personnel. It is highly desirable that the 2 officers at present on duty with this detachment remain.

Attached is a letter from Commanding Officer, Student Training Regiment requesting that the Service Company, 1st Bn, be organized now with the personnel of the 25th Infantry which at this time are serving a company cadre in the Biglerville area. The number of personnel involved is two officers and 24 enlisted men.</p> <p>2. What CO, STR is actually trying to accomplish is the transfer of the two officers and 24 enlisted men so that he could have them available to run a colored mess in the Biglerville area. It is contemplated that such a mess be established to take care of the administration of firemen, janitors, orderlies, and probably mess personnel for the Student Officer Companies. <i>These men are being withdrawn by 25th - Wed - 7 May.</i></p> <p>3. At the present time there are 238 negroes assigned to STR. This figure must be raised to 351 by 1 July. I believe it would be a good idea to begin fitting negro enlisted men into their new jobs now, and therefore recommend that the company cadre from 25th Infantry now employed in Biglerville, be attached unassigned to STR, and that they be assigned when the new TDs are published. With respect to the two officers, CO, STR informed me that they appear to be highly efficient in the handling of negro personnel. There has been only one Summary Court case in this company in approximately two months. 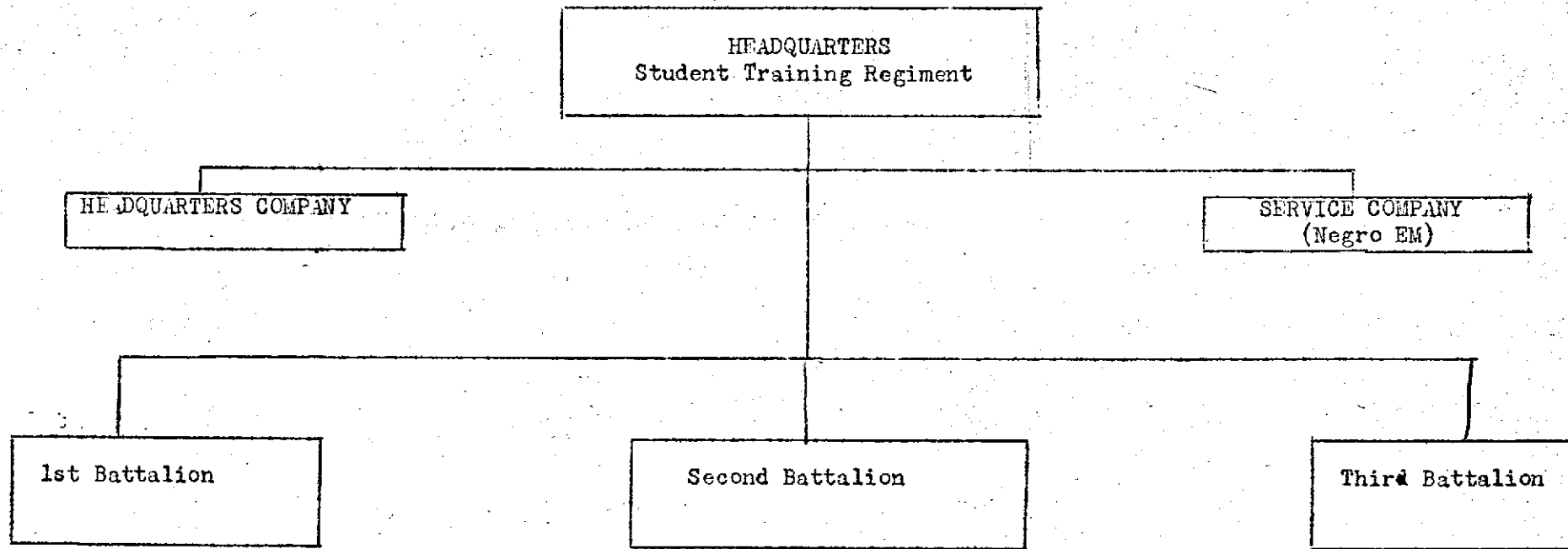

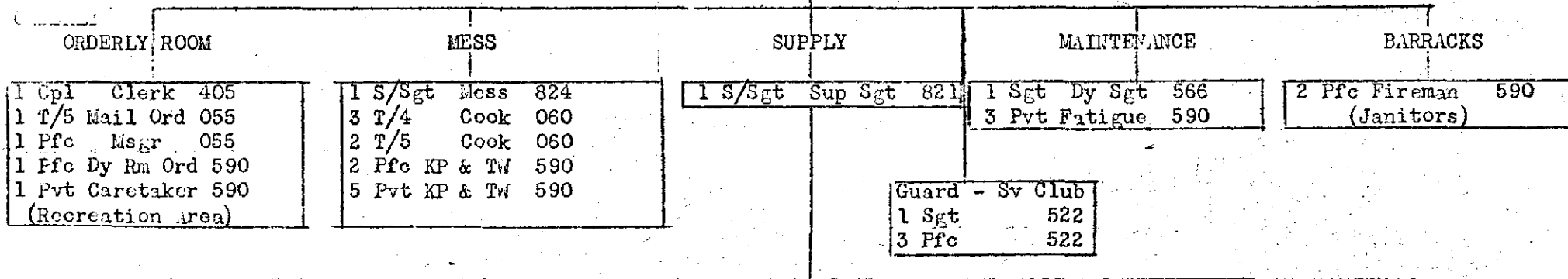
