1. It is understood that recommendations of TIC Reorganization Board to the effect that the 1st Student Brigade be retained as an organization and that there be assigned to it in addition to the presently assigned 1st and 2nd Student Regiments, the 13d and the 1st OC Regiment, has been approved.

2. Based on this assumption 3rd Army Manpower Team has provided a T/D for the Headquarters, 1st Student Brigade to include a Command Section, S-1 and Adjutant's Section, S-2 and S-3 Section, and an S-4 Section which totals 13 officers, 1 warrant officer, 21 enlisted men and 6 civilians. Under this figure it will be necessary for the following responsibilities and functions presently being performed by this headquarters to be transferred to higher headquarters or to Regiments as indicated:

a. Personnel Administration of Brigade Headquarters. (PO) personnel transferred to 1st Student Regiment.

b. Headquarters Company should be redesignated a Brigade Headquarters Detachment and it be attached to Headquarters Company, 1st Student Regiment. Headquarters Commandant functions must then be assumed by Commanding Officer, Headquarters Company, 1st Student Regiment.

c. Monthly School Training Report (reference Memorandum TIB, dated 4 March 1953) be transferred to Operations, The Infantry School, with information required from Brigade being furnished in feeder reports direct from Regiments.

d. Responsibility for preparation, reproduction, and distribution of class rosters (300 to 400 copies of each class) shifted to Regiments concerned.

- g. Requisitions for, classification and assignment of, and levy quotas pertaining to officers and enlisted men must be made by TIC AG direct to Regiments with advice from Brigade Headquarters on officer assignment only.
- h. Civilian personnel administration to be handled by AG Civilian Personnel Division. Time and attendance reports submitted direct from Regiments and Brigade Headquarters to TIC AG.
- i. Correspondence requiring expeditious handling, i.e., airborne training, student release requests, indebtedness, etc., be handled direct between TIC AG and Regiments.
- j. Requests for change in orders or correction in orders by students be handled by G-1 and AG direct to Regiments. (This normally requires numerous telephone calls to DA.)
- k. Administration of safety program be handled by TIC Safety Section direct to Regiments.
- l. Work Measurement reports to be prepared by Regiments and forwarded direct to TIC.
- m. The change in MS of legal officer from 3103 and 2120 withdrawn authorization for a complete set of legal authorities. Without these authorities the legal assistance currently being accomplished must be referred to Staff Judge Advocate TIC. It is believed arrangement could be made with the Staff Judge Advocate to make legal library available to this Legal Section.
- n. Request for training aids from Regiments directly to 2nd Army Training Aids Center.
